

Guillain-Barré syndrome – A disorder affecting the peripheral nervous system

Wegener's Disease – inflammation of blood vessels that affects the nose, lungs, kidneys, and other organs

Sarcoidosis– a disease in which abnormal collections of chronic inflammatory cells form as nodules in multiple organs

Haemochromatosis – iron deficiency

African trypanosomiasis – also known as African sleeping sickness

Addison's disease – a disease in which the adrenal glands do not produce enough steroid hormones

Alkaptonuria – sometimes called black urine disease

Porphyria – disease affecting the heme pathway in humans and sometimes used to describe the origins of vampires and werewolves

Schistosomiasis – an infection by a parasite

Wilson's disease – copper accumulation disease

Fabry disease – a lysosomal storage disease

Leishmaniasis – an infectious disease that is transmitted by the bite of a sand fly.

Sporotrichosis – a disease caused by a fungus usually obtain from a rose bush

Leptospirosis – a disease caused by a bacteria called Leptospira

Menkes disease is a disorder that affects copper levels in the body, leading to copper deficiency
